Summer Mission Trips

We're all about bringing new hope to the poor, broken, homeless, drug and alcohol addicted, and counterculture people. As the physical needs of people increase, so do the spiritual needs. **It's not a test anymore, it IS an emergency**; the clock is ticking and He IS coming soon! I've been street witnessing for most of my life. I have never seen such a hunger to get right with God as I have in the last year.

Jesus said, "No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him . . ." (John 6:44) It's only because of Him that we usually bring a few guys back to the ranch off the streets of Spokane on our Monday night outreach. They come to learn more about Jesus.

Our evangelism team keeps busy in the summer almost every weekend going to secular festivals as the Lord leads: Anaconda, MT, the National Rainbow Gathering, Bike Fest in Sturgis S. Dakota, Reggae in the Redwoods, back street outreaches in Vegas, Phoenix, LA, San Francisco, and NW fall & spring Barter Fairs. We give meals, gift bags, healthy snacks, and essentials to the homeless and have a hot dog cart that feeds hungry souls. What is more valuable than a man's soul? Lives are being radically turned around and it is our honor to be there for them!

To offset the cost of the trip, we worked security and clean-up at Sturgis Bike Festival*. I think the Lord allows these trials to show Himself strong and build faith in the team. Ministry opportunities were everywhere and our presence made an impact on many lives.

We set up our bus and free kitchen right at the main trailhead and ministered to hundreds of New-agers, hippies, and Rainbow kids. Our camp was always full of people drawn by the love of Jesus, christian music, and Bible reading. The gospel was preached, people got fed, over twenty commitments to Christ were made, and we baptized five of them in the river.


Soldier of the Month

I was a successful dealer, had plenty of run-ins with the law, was labeled Tukwila's most wanted, hated by the cops, the community, and rival dealers. I remembered what my Grandmother said and cried out to God. Two days later, the Lord sent the guys from the Lord's Ranch to share the gospel with me. I accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior and came to the ranch. Remembering the plans I made to do evil the same day the guys ran into me, I knew that God gave me a way out, or I could have ended up in prison instead.

I thank God for the Lord's Ranch because it's a good place to recognize the goodness of God. This is not a treatment center, it is a family that allows a person to freely seek after God. I learned alot here and served as House Manager for nearly three years. I dealt with my past, God gave me favor with the law, and I was released from probation five months early. He has blessed me beyond comprehension. I am now a free man, free from jail, and free from bondage.
